







## **Intercollegiate Specialty Fellowship Examinations – Transitional Arrangements 2021/22**

A. Candidates who have passed a minimum of one component of a current ISFE by July 2021

Passed one or two components by July 2021



Resit at final diet of current format exam autumn 2021



If unsuccessful resit Part A (Feb 2022) and/or Part B (Spring 2022)

B. Candidates applying for autumn 2021 diet who meet the current ISFE eligibility criteria

Sit at final diet of current format exam autumn 2021



If unsuccessful resit Part A (Feb 2022) and/or Part B section(s) (Spring 2022)

C. Candidates applying for the autumn 2021 diet who do not yet meet the eligibility criteria for the new Part B examination

Sit new format Part A in September 2021



If unsuccessful resit Part A (Feb 2022)



If successful in Part A Feb 2022 first available opportunity to apply for Part B
- Autumn 2022

Sit new format Part A in September 2021



If successful, first available opportunity to apply for Part B - Spring 2022

D. Candidates intending to apply for their first attempt in 2022 who meet the eligibility criteria for both Part A and Part B examinations OR those resitting Part A in 2022 (having had a first attempt in Sept 2021 or Feb 2022) who now meet the eligibility criteria for Part B

Sit Part A (Feb 2022) and Part B (Spring 2022) or Part A (Sept 2022) and Part B (Autumn 2022)



If unsuccessful resit Part A and/or Part B section(s) at the subsequent diets

**NOTES:** Candidates in categories A and B above who require a re-sit attempt after sitting the autumn 2021 diet may apply for Parts A and B at the same time if required and are not required to pass Part A before attempting Part B.

Candidates in category C must pass Part A and meet the eligibility criteria for Part B before applying for an attempt at Part B.

Candidates in category D are not required to pass Part A before attempting Part B.
