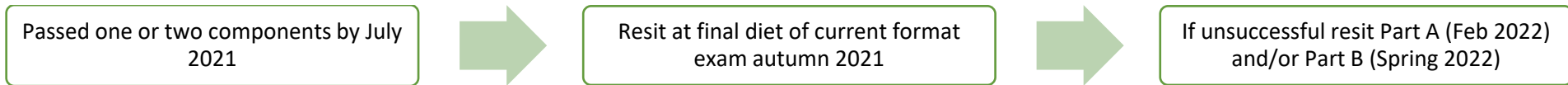


Intercollegiate Specialty Fellowship Examinations – Transitional Arrangements 2021/22

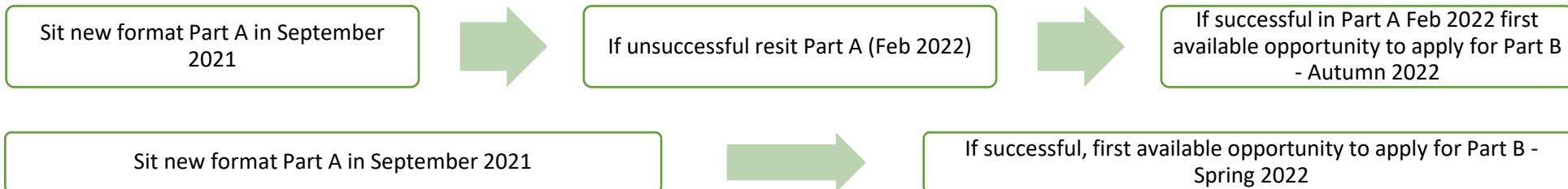
A. Candidates who have passed a minimum of one component of a current ISFE by July 2021



B. Candidates applying for autumn 2021 diet who meet the current ISFE eligibility criteria



C. Candidates applying for the autumn 2021 diet who do not yet meet the eligibility criteria for the new Part B examination



D. Candidates intending to apply for their first attempt in 2022 who meet the eligibility criteria for both Part A and Part B examinations OR those re-sitting Part A in 2022 (having had a first attempt in Sept 2021 or Feb 2022) who now meet the eligibility criteria for Part B



NOTES: Candidates in categories A and B above who require a re-sit attempt after sitting the autumn 2021 diet may apply for Parts A and B at the same time if required and are not required to pass Part A before attempting Part B.

Candidates in category C must pass Part A and meet the eligibility criteria for Part B before applying for an attempt at Part B.

Candidates in category D are not required to pass Part A before attempting Part B.
