The information below will be provided to candidates during assimilation.

Scenario

10-minute assimilation / 15 minutes examination

You have recently taken up your position as a consultant in restorative dentistry in a district general hospital. You discover that there are only OPT facilities in the clinic. There is no dental X-ray equipment available to take or process intra-oral radiographs. In addition, you are planning to develop the dental implantology service and will require a cone-beam CT scanner to aid in planning.

Be prepared to discuss your concerns and management plan to allow you to develop and modernise the radiography service.

Scenario

10-minute assimilation / 15 minutes examination

1. Outline how you would manage this situation in the short-term.
2. Outline in detail how you will plan a business case to procure a dental X-ray machine and dental processing equipment for the clinic.
3. Discuss how you might engage with your local dental committees and networks about this problem and seeking a solution.
4. Who would you seek support from in managing this situation?
5. When considering options, what is likely to have significant impact and what are the benefits and shortcomings of these options?
