



MEMBERSHIP IN ORTHODONTICS – CHENNAI

GUIDANCE TO APPLICANTS - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How do I know if I am eligible to sit the Membership in Orthodontics examination?

You should send the application form and an updated CV with details of your undergraduate and postgraduate training to the Examinations Office (MOrth), Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow, 232-242 St Vincent Street, Glasgow, G2 5RJ. Members of the Examination Board will then review your details and advise us of your eligibility status: if additional information is required, we will contact you to request this.

2. What are the dates of the Membership in Orthodontics examinations?

The Membership in Orthodontics Part 1 examination will take place on 11 May 2020: the Part 2 examination will take place on 29, 30 June and 1 July 2020.

3. When can I register for the Membership in Orthodontics examination?

The registration window for Parts 1 and 2 is from 6 January to 21 February 2020.

4. Can I sit the Membership in Orthodontics Part 2 if haven't passed the Membership in Orthodontics Part 1?

You can register to sit the Membership in Orthodontics Part 2 before you have received your result for the Part 1 examination. However, you will not be awarded the MOrth RCPS(Glasg) until you have passed both parts.

5. I sat the Membership in Orthodontics Part 2 previously and failed certain components. Can I be given exemption from the components I have already passed?

You cannot be exempted from the OSCE or Structured Clinical Reasoning components. The Examination Board will decide if you need to re-sit the Treated Cases component. You will be informed of this, after you have registered for the examination.

6. What is the examination fee?

Membership in Orthodontics Part 1 fee - £530

Membership in Orthodontics Part 2 fee - £1500

7. When do I need to submit the examination fee?

Once your application form and CV have been reviewed by the Examination Board, we will contact you to advise on your eligibility. If your eligibility is confirmed, you will receive details of how to submit the exam fee, confirming the deadline for receipt of payment.
