



MEMBERSHIP IN ORTHODONTICS – CHENNAI

GUIDANCE TO APPLICANTS - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How do I know if I am eligible to sit the Membership in Orthodontics examination?

You should email the completed application form and an updated CV with details of your undergraduate and postgraduate training to morth@rcpsg.ac.uk. Members of the Examination Board will then review your details and advise us of your eligibility status. If additional information is required, we will contact you to request this.

2. Where and when will the Membership in Orthodontics examinations take place?

The Membership in Orthodontics Part 1 examination will take place on 27th October 2022. The Part 2 examination will take place on 25th, 28th, 29th and 30th November. The exams will take place online.

3. When can I register for the Membership in Orthodontics examination?

The registration window for Parts 1 and 2 is from 11 July 2022 to 19th September 2022.

4. Can I sit the Membership in Orthodontics Part 2 if haven't passed the Membership in Orthodontics Part 1?

You can register to sit the Membership in Orthodontics Part 2 before you have received your result for the Part 1 examination. However, you will not be awarded the MOrth RCPS(Glasg) until you have passed both parts.

5. I sat the Membership in Orthodontics Part 2 previously and failed certain components. Can I be given exemption from the components I have already passed?

For M Orth Part 2, marks from previously passed components can be carried forward to one successive diet. If you fail the examination more than once, you will need to sit all components for any future attempts.

6. What is the examination fee?

Membership in Orthodontics Part 1 fee - £500

Membership in Orthodontics Part 2 fee - £1750

7. When do I need to submit the examination fee?

Once your application form and CV have been reviewed by the Examination Board, we will contact you to advise on your eligibility. If your eligibility is confirmed, you will receive details of how to submit the exam fee, confirming the deadline for receipt of payment.
