Regulation 7: Admission to the Examination

With effect from the opening date for the Glasgow examination diet, 20 February 2019, candidates will be able to apply online for the examination. Prior to completing the application form candidates are required to create an online account here https://rcpsg.ac.uk/register, using their Person ID (PID) number.

The online application form can only be completed and submitted between the opening and closing date for applications, shown on the dates and fees page. Only one form per candidate can be submitted.

Submission of the online form does not guarantee a place on the examination. Details of the procedure for allocation of examination places are shown below and on the dates and fees page.

The Regulations and Guidance to Candidates have been updated to reflect the introduction of online applications.

Regulation 7: Admission to the Examination

With effect from 1 October 2017, a new process for allocating places for the Part 3 examination was implemented.

The application process will remain the same, with multiple examination diets open during the same application period and candidates indicating their first, second and third choice centres. Duplicate application forms will not be accepted.

After the closing date for applications, places will be allocated to eligible applicants who have been selected at random from all those who have applied between the published opening and closing dates. Candidates will be allocated either their first, second or third choice centre, depending on availability. Once all available examination and waiting list places have been allocated, candidates will be notified and application forms from those who have not been allocated a place will be destroyed.

The Regulations and Guidance to Candidates have been updated to reflect this. Applicants should also refer to the additional terms and conditions of application published on the dates and fees document on the website.
