Candidates may still apply to the Glasgow College as their College of entry even though the OSCE Examination will take place at one of the other Colleges.

Candidate may **only apply to one College at each sitting**. Candidates who enter an examination with more than one of the four colleges at the same sitting will forfeit the fee for each additional application.

## Exam Fee Payment, Transfers & Withdrawals

Exam fee payment is due to be paid within 2 weeks of receipt of your exam confirmation email.

A candidate who withdraws in writing before the closing date for application may be refunded the fee paid less an administrative fee of 20%. No refunds are normally made to candidates who withdraw after the closing date.

Requests for a withdrawal or refund on medical grounds must accompanied by a medical certificate. Similarly, requests for a transfer or refund on compassionate grounds should be supported by a letter from your College / Clinical Tutor or the Assigned Educational Supervisor and the Head of the School of Surgery. All such applications must be submitted to us within 14 days of the examination date. Full details can be found in the regulations.

## **Important Notes**

Fees are correct at the time of publication: The College may amend these fees in advance of the closing date.

The College may either cancel an examination centre if there are insufficient candidates or restrict numbers should this be necessary.

In the unlikely event that the College has to cancel an examination, the examination fee shall be reimbursed, but the College shall incur no further liability
